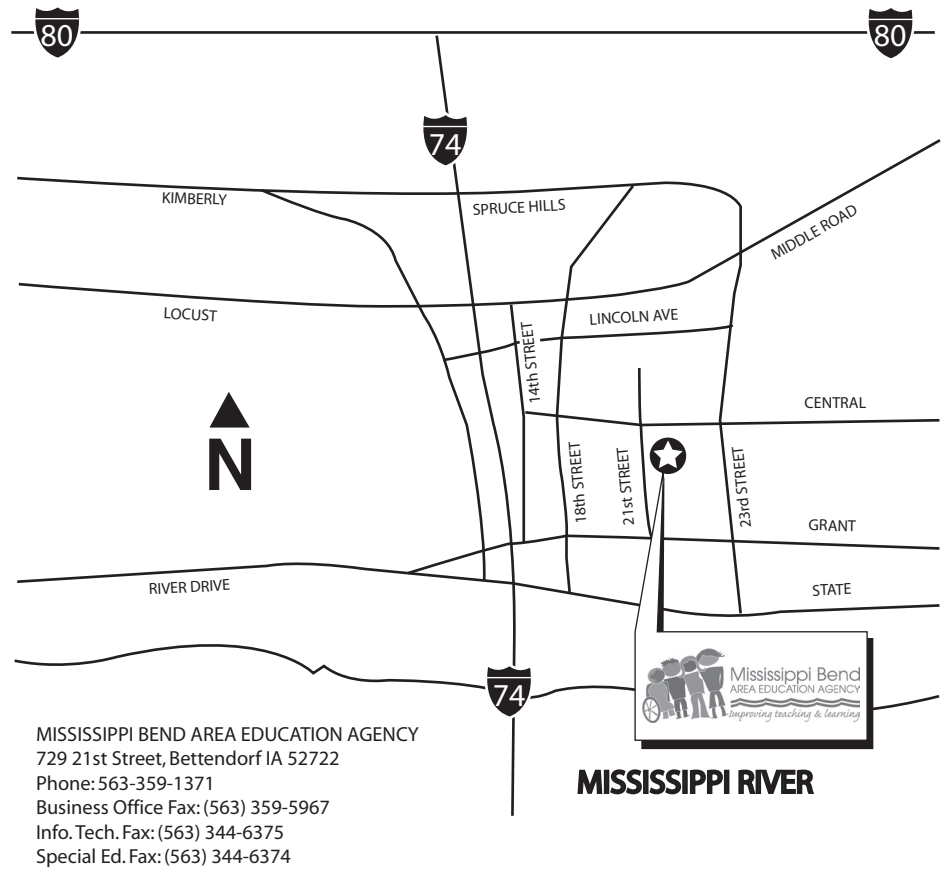

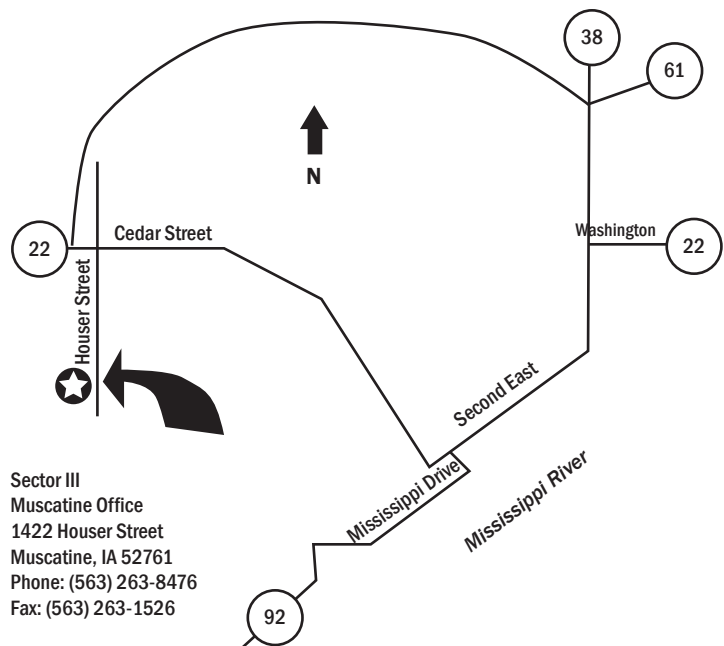

Sector II & IV (Bettendorf Office)



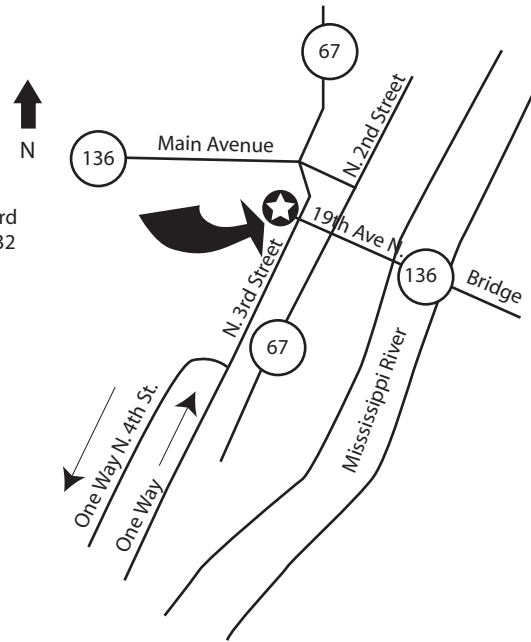
